Mendeley Readers is a research statistic which counts the sum of unique Mendeley users who have added a given research output to their Mendeley library. Mendeley Reader counts have been positively correlated with future citation impact in a number of studies, including Li & Thelwall, 2012; Zahedia, Costas, and Wouters, 2014; Thelwall, 2018. Professor Mike Thelwall of the University of Wolverhampton finds that Mendeley Readers typically appear at least a year before citations due to delays between other researchers reading a paper and their new study being published (source). In this way, Mendeley Reader counts can help you to predict the impact that a recently-published article will have and is a useful indicator for evaluating the context of a journal article. We caution that Mendeley Reader counts are inferred from crowdsourced data and Elsevier does not currently endorse using it as a direct measure of research impact. Was this answer helpful? Mendeley Web Library was replaced with Mendeley Reference Manager on September 07, 2020. We have now stopped all development work on Mendeley Desktop, and there will be no further updates to Mendeley Desktop beyond the current version. Our full development effort is now focused on the new Mendeley Reference Manager so that we can add the features users are telling us they want. When will Mendeley Desktop stop being available? Once we are confident that the new Mendeley Reference Manager meets our users' reference management needs we will start to begin the migration process by notifying you via emails and other forms of communication. To migrate over to the new Mendeley Reference Manager, you will need to make sure you have synced your current Mendeley Desktop and then download the new Mendeley Reference Manager. Having synced your Desktop, all of your work will then exist in the new Mendeley Reference Manager. Key to helping us make the decision of when to start the migration is user feedback. The feedback we receive from users is vital in helping us make the right product development decisions. To provide feedback, open Mendeley Reference Manager, go to Account & Help and select Give Feedback. Why are not all my PDFs stored locally by default? The new Mendeley Reference Manager library is cloud-based. This is to ensure your latest changes are always saved and that you can access your references on multiple devices. If you would like a specific file attachment stored locally, you can download that file to your local machine by opening it in the reader and selecting the download icon. When the user clicks the ribbon, the add-in window opens on the right-hand panel, however, the app itself does not load and displays a white screen. This issue is caused by internet security settings, which applies to users using Mendeley Cite in Word Desktop. To resolve these issues, depending on the operating system you are using, you will need to adjust your internet security settings to allow JavaScript to run. Windows users: The Internet Explorer 11 desktop application is retired and out of support as of June 15, 2022 for certain versions of Windows 10. You will need to make sure that in your Internet Explorer Security Zone, Internet is set to 'Medium-High', as any higher setting will not allow our JavaScript app to run on windows.
